


Ebola Waste Management for Non-Healthcare Settings

This flow chart shows how Ebola virus-related wastes generated from the cleaning/decontamination of a home or other non-healthcare setting should be managed. For more information contact the local public or environmental health department or the California Department of Public Health.



*A 6-log (10⁶) reduction or "kill" efficacy is required of the inactivation or treatment process.

"Ebola-associated waste that has been treated (incinerated, autoclaved, or otherwise inactivated) is not infectious, does not pose a health risk, and is not considered to be regulated medical waste or a hazardous material under federal law."
